## **Brief History**

The hitching post, erected in 1900, is the single remaining example of the many hitching posts erected in and around the Square in the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries by the Palmerston North Borough Council. Horse-drawn transport remained predominant in Palmerston North for some decades after the turn of the century.

The painted wooden post with ring and bolt attachment has a reversed scalloped decoration on top, and was probably once part of a post and rail fence, as a morticed cavity remains on one face.
